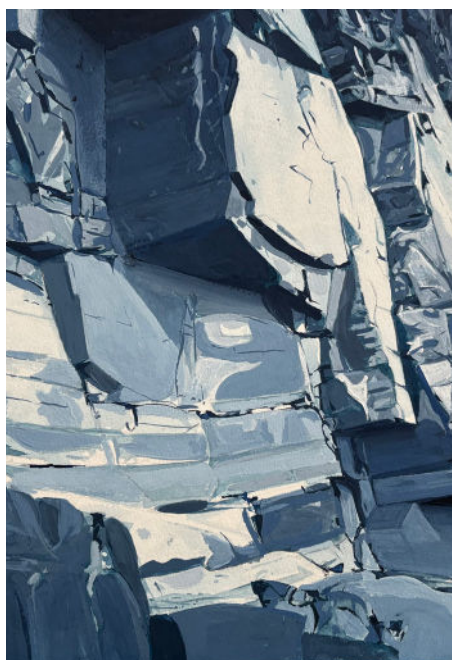


Where The Light Lives

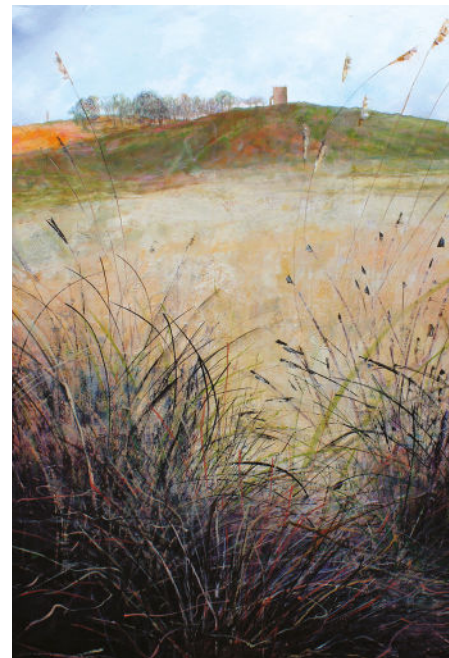
About Time

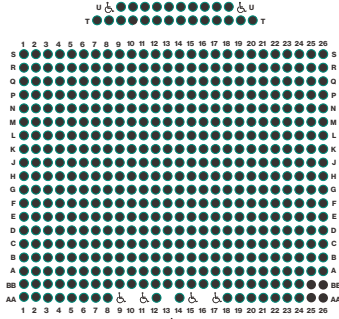

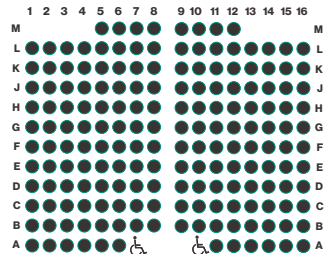
